- 1. Eagle's Cliff Chenin Blanc 2006/7, Brede Valley (South Africa)**
Aromatic, fruity, medium-sweet. Good all-round white! **£13.95.**
 - 2. Norte Chico Chardonnay 2006/7, Central Valley (Chile)**
Perfect for a glass of dry white with 'drinkability' and character but not overwhelmed with oak flavours. **£13.95**
 - 3. Norte Chico Sauvignon Blanc 2006/7**
Lovely crisp, fruity Sauvignon from Chili. Absurdly inexpensive for this quality. **£13.95.**
 - 4. Pinot Grigio, Allamanda 2008 (Italy)**
A medium body crisp wine with citrus aroma and the taste of ripe apples & pears. **£13.95**
 - 5. Trivento Tribu Sauvignon Blanc (Argentina)**
A classic South American white. **£14.95**
 - 6. Forrest Estate Sauvignon Blanc 2006 (New Zealand)**
'Benchmark' Sauvignon Blanc from a small prestigious producer. **£17.50**
 - 7. Macon-Lugny les petite pierres**
Modestly priced but high in quality, this Macon-Lugny has the fresh taste of the Chardonnay to the fore, with gentle 'buttery' overtones. **£21.50**
 - 8. Chablis 2005, Louis Jadot**
Stylish Chablis from the renowned house of Jadot. **£22.50**
 - 9. Poilly-Fumé, Domaine des Mariniers.**
Delicate, crisp, bone-dry and flinty, with minerally flavours and a lovely whiff of smokiness on the nose. **£27.50**

- 10. Norte Chico Rosé 2006, Chile**
Lovely lightweight rosé, with overtones of strawberries on the palate. Ideal for a summer's day. **£13.95**

White Dessert Wine

11. Muscat de Beames de Venise

Famous dessert wine from the southern Rhône, in convenient half-bottles.

Red Wine by the Bottle

12. Norte Chico Cabernet Sauvignon 2008 (Chile)

Excellent all-purpose dry red from Chile. *£13.95*

13. Norte Chico Merlot 2008, (Chile)

Full bodied and rich medium red. This merlot takes some beating! *£13.95*

14. Sichel Bel-Air Bordeaux 2008 *£13.95*

15. Don Cristobal Malbec, Mendoza

Malbec is Argentina's 'trademark' grape. This wine is full-flavoured, rich and delicious. *£14.50*

16. Beresford "Highwood" Merlot 2006 (South Australia)

Deep red with purple hues, displays mulberry and dark plum characters with a supple mid-palate.
£15.50

17. William's Well Reserve Shiraz

Big, spicy, fruity and sturdy red from south-east Australia.
Goes very well with all strong meat dishes. But not with fish!

18. Fleurie 'Domaine de la Madone' 2005, Beaujolais

Lovely lightweight fruity red, redolent of raspberries – perfect for a summer's day. *£21.50*

19. Coto de Imaz Reserva 2001 Rioja

Classic Rioja here, with all the 'guts' and body that one expects, and with great depth of flavour and plenty of 'bite'. Accompanies all strong meat dishes. And a good winter wine! *£23.50*

20. Aglieno, Toscano Rosso

This little-known wine comes from a Chianti producer just outside the beautiful mediæval Tuscan town of San Gimignano. It is made of 65% Sangiovese - the classic Chianti grape - tempered with 35% Merlot, which lends a hint of claret to the flavour. *£26.50*

21. Chateau la Tour de By 2001, Médoc

The wine is made with great care, with at least one year in oak *barriques*, It has the classic 'cigar-box' aroma and cedary taste of fine claret. *£29.50*

Sparkling

22. Willow Glen sparkling, south-east Australia

Dry, inexpensive and popular fizz. *£13.50*

23. Champagne Bernard Rémy

Dry, creamy, 'biscuity' Champagne – delicious, and very good value. *£25.50*
